PRESIDENTS REPORT

Richard informed the members present of the items discussed at the Committee Meeting 22nd June 2016.

A PA system with desk Microphones and stands was needed for meetings and events and tonight the System was working well.

The time scale for the proposed new constitution should be completed within 12 months and ready to present to the Members at the next AGM 2017 for their acceptance.

Richard has had a letter from Tony Collins Event Coordinator of the Ulysses Motorcycle Club Fremantle who is organising an event on the September long weekend 2017 in Collie. The event will run over 2 days with Vintage and Veteran Motorcycles, with the aim of bringing more people to Collie to support local businesses.

On Sunday there will be a parade of motorcycles and the IHC will make it a sanctioned ride so that our members can ride their concessional bikes. The event is on the same weekend as our Wheatbelt Run so members can choose which event they wish to attend, although one is suitable for older bikes and one for more modern bikes.

We are carrying out a revue of our current insurance which will be talked about more in General Business.

The Bunbury City Council sent the IHC a letter suggesting that the club shed should be insured for \$34,000, so Richard has approached a couple of shed builders in town to get an estimate of the cost of a shed of the size that our shed is and the quotes were \$12,000. Richard has taken the quotes that he received to the Bunbury City Council.

Bill pike has come up with a new clause for the indemnity form for the 2 Day Rally which can be used for all our events and rides.

Our rides have been developed around social riding and safe group riding.

All participating riders of this event are required to be licensed and expected to hold insurance policies. All machines must be registered and roadworthy.

All road rules are to be adhered to and any form of unruly behaviour will not be accepted. In the event of an accident I will not hold the organisers or the club officials responsible. The organising committee reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone they deem to be unruly, or who are not abiding by the rules.

LICENSING LIAISON OFFICERS RE-PORT

An update from Paul Barfoot from the Vellocette Club regarding Mandatory Testing of riders over age 85 - he has had notification from Parik Lumb (Policy Administrator at the Transport Dept.) that policy change review was underway - this is very encouraging for a

change in the current rules. We will keep you informed as information comes to hand.

New Expanded Motor Injury Insurance (no Blame Insurance) rates will be added on to any vehicle license renewal since the 1st of July 2016. This is the insurance forced upon us whether we like it or not, to cover any catastrophic injury not covered by current 3rd Party Insurance.

When you get your <u>Concession 404</u> vehicle license renewal, check that the insurance class is 7a - this will give you a reduction for your concession 404 vehicle down from \$99 to \$30 per vehicle.

For those who are interested the new expanded cover rates are as follows:-Cars + \$99

Trucks + \$94

Medium & Large Motorcycles + \$99

Medium & Large Motorcycles + \$99 Caravans & Trailers + \$0 Forklifts & Tractors +\$25

Small Motorcycles & concessional vehicles +\$30

Richard will contact the Albany Club and VMCCWA to see how they approach the insurance for their events. In the meantime ideas are sought from members as to what alternatives we can use for the 2 Day Rally -i.e. Have stop signs at checkpoints where riders have to sign in instead of being timed.
