PRESIDENTS REPORT

Bob highlighted issues that were discussed at the Committee Meeting 18th November 2015.

For those that wish to Camp at the BMCC on the weekend of the Two Day Rally they will have to supply their own Power. Section #10 of the Proposed Constitution was discussed relating to Committee and Membership, with a few changes that would be implemented when the final draft is done.

Riders Licences

It is not up to the Captain or whoever is running the ride to check rider's licences. If they are made aware that someone is riding on an incorrect licence then they have a responsibility to act on that information.

The rider can then be told that they cannot ride because they do not have the correct licence and if they do not obey they should be reported to the police.

An updated indemnification form with I DE-CLARE THAT MY MOTORCYCLE IS CURRENTLY LICENCED AND ROAD-WORTHY AND THAT I HOLD THE AP-PROPRIATE DRIVER'S LICENCE FOR THE MOTORCYCLE I AM RIDING

Name Signature Passenger's Name is on the website and Leith has also sent Busselton and Mandurah a copy. The Indemnification forms will be numbered after amendments are made so that members can be informed which version to use.

A motorcycle licence -"R" is needed for a Trike or Canam (see the response from Jeff's enquiry from DOT below) It was agreed that it is a good idea to inspect B class licenced bikes, but not the responsibility of the Club to inspect A Class bikes Jeff received the response below from the Department of Transport to his question of what licence is needed to ride a Trike or Canam.

Dear Mr Smith,

Thank you for your enquiry.

Please be advised, clients who have previously

sat their R-E or R class practical riding assessment on a 3 wheeled motor cycle and they have a restriction code 31 on their licence will need to re-apply for the R-E or R class to get the restriction removed, if they wish to ride a standard motorcycle.

If they already hold an R-E or R class with no restrictions, they can ride a 3 wheel motorcycle.

If you hold R-E driver's licence, the client must be riding a LAMS approved motorcycle with an engine capacity not exceeding 660cc and with a power to weight ratio not exceeding 150 kw/t (with foot or hand operated clutch).

If you hold an R class (open), a motorcycle with an engine capacity exceeding 660cc or a power to weight ratio exceeding 150 kw/t (R class holders can ride any motorcycle), this includes a three wheeled trike or Canam.

If the trike has been modified to fit a wheelchair, the engine capacity and the class of licence that you hold is still the same as above.

LICENSING LIAISON OFFICERS REPORT

Concession 404

Jeff said that DOT rules as they stand at the moment are that if you have a bike on a code 404 licence there is a new condition code stating that you must be a financial member of an approved motorcycle club and that the bike must be an original with no modifications.

The IHC membership fees are due on the 1st December each year and you have until the 30th December to pay. If your membership is not paid by 30th December in DOT's eyes you are unlicensed

and uninsured, so make sure you pay your memberships early to avoid disappointment.

If you have a bike on an A class licence and you want to put it on a B class licence you no longer have to have it inspected, just take the current licence papers with a letter from Jeff Smith our Licencing Liaison Officer, stating that you are a financial member of the Club to DOT.

CMC delegates are working with DOT policy staff to ensure that they have some input into any new legislation that is introduced. They are working to remove the possibility of the introduction of log books that may have been introduced. It has been recommended by the CMC that clubs still conduct annual **safety** inspections of code 404 licenced bikes.

There are new Certificate of Safety Examination forms, so if examiners have any of the old forms please throw them away and Jeff will issue you with the new forms.

Your bike still has to be examined by your clubs examiner or scrutineer.


