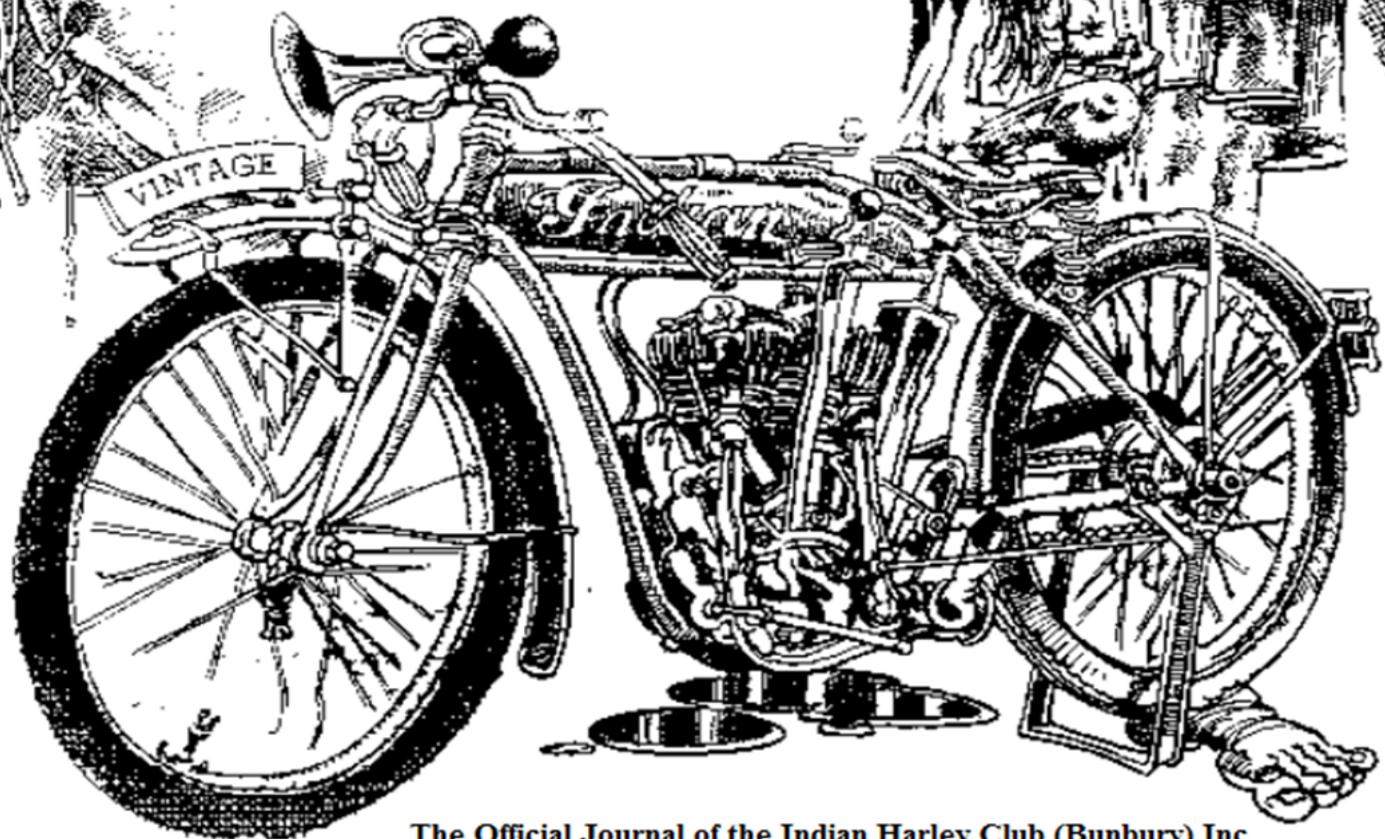

Modifications to major systems of motor vehicles or bikes licenced under Code 404 regulations are not permitted.

Modifications to minor systems i.e. 6 volt to 12-volt conversion or additional lighting for safety reasons are permitted at the discretion of the licencing officer.

Modifications made after the vehicle has been licenced would result in the vehicle being considered unlicensed and therefore uninsured.

With regards to what people are insured for, the NDIS is only available to people between the ages of 7 and 65 years of age.

No Blame Insurance only applies to catastrophic injuries. There have been very few successful claims against this insurance.

A lot of effort has gone into ensuring that the Platypus Mountain Runs are good value for money, traveling along roads less travelled and staying in a mixture of hotels and home stays with Vietnamese families.

The bikes and guides for the 14-day rally are provided by a company in Hanoi, who ensure the bikes are well maintained and reliable. \$500.00 from each rider goes towards directly to the charity to fund their work.

Following Bob's talk, John Coleman told members that he had ridden in several of these runs and had a great time. The rides were great value for money and the bikes were good.

Having a great time while putting some money into a great cause – what could be better?

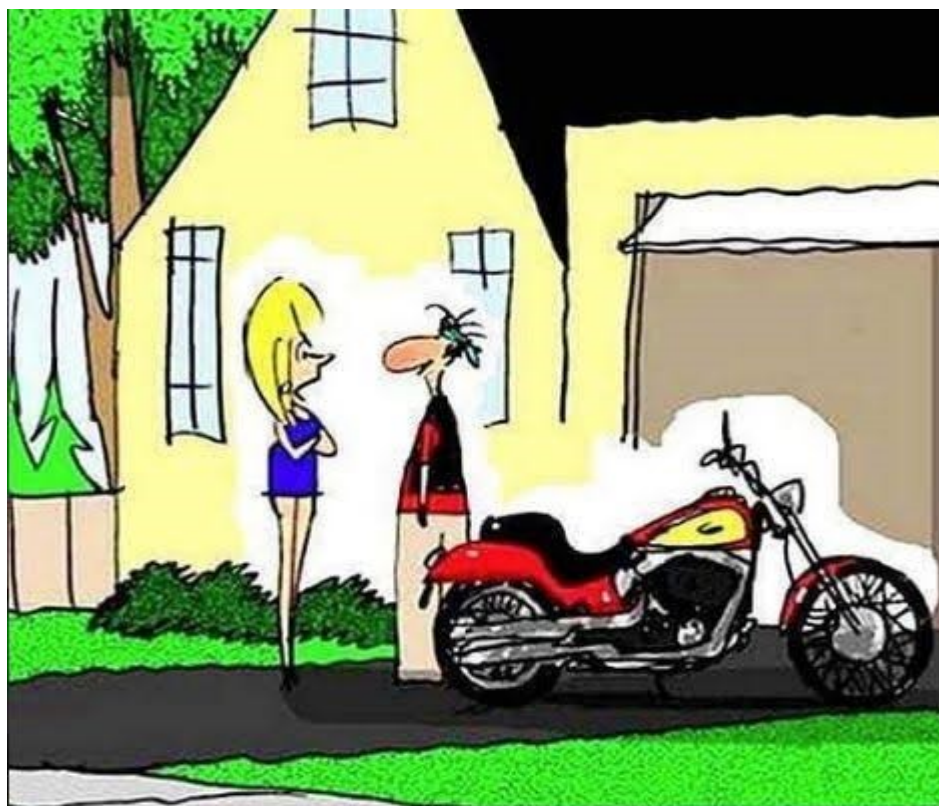
