This makes you a winner two fold, you have the potential to save money, and you will not run the risk of jeopardising your concession 404 licence.

We are still looking for a Secretary to fill the position when Faye stands down after the AGM in July. It is not a difficult job but one that takes a considerable amount of time, so if you have some spare time and would like to learn the way the Club works please consider it.

The job does not necessarily have to be done by a club member it can be the husband/wife or girlfriend/boyfriend of a member, so please if there is someone that would be willing to take over the position contact Faye so that she can give you a bit of training before the AGM.

PROPERTY OFFICERS REPORT

Ross said when he checked the shed for the First Aid Kits in readiness for the 2 Day Rally he discovered that 2 of the 3 were missing.

The one locked in the toolbox in the trailer was still there, but the 2 kits that were just sitting on the shelves were missing. LICENSING LIAISON OFFICERS REPORT

The grace period for paying you membership fees is nil, this is nothing to do with the Club it is a directive from the Department of Transport. If you pay your membership fees after the 31st December your concessionally licenced bike will be unlicensed and uninsured.

Jeff will be watching this closely because he has to put his report in on the 1st January each year.

Over 85's

The Department of Transport have been in meetings within the department itself, but nothing to do with the minister, making all of our letters to the ministers a bit of a waste.

The new minister has to endorse the policy change about over 85's not needing a practical test; it has been approved within the department it just needs to be approved by the minister.

When this is done there will need to be administrative, websites and publication changes before it can be adopted. If all goes to plan a 3 year trial could start as early as March this year. It is proposed that the 3 year trial will remove the need for over 85's to undergo a practical riding test providing they meet the medical requirements.

If you are issued with a letter from the Department of Transport on turning 85 years of age please show it to Jeff so that he can help you fill it in correctly that way you will not hinder your chances of keeping your licence.

Moving from an "A" to "B" class you no longer require a letter from Jeff or the Club, what you need to do is fill out the new CMC1 form which states that your bike is over 25 years of age and meets the requirements of Concession 404.

The new CMC1 form is to be signed by Murray in his capacity as Machine Examiner, and the form needs to be taken by the club member to the D.O.T. to be counter signed.

When the new CMC1 form was introduced at the start of February the Department of Transport took away all the agencies rights to endorse or code the form, which means you will need to take your form into a DOT official office.

If you take your form into an agency please be prepared to wait a day or two because they will need to fax it to an official DOT office.

WEBSITE MANAGER REPORT

We have now introduced multi period memberships. At any time, you can log in to your profile on our website and add a year to your membership. Why would you want to do this? If you extend your membership before the AGM you will lock in next year's membership at this year's prices should any increase in fees occur.

And in addition, you will be spared getting endless annoying emails and invoices at the end of the year. If you have a concessionally licensed bike you will have no risk of membership lapsing and causing problems with your licence and insurance. Of course, we can also accept cheques in the mail, but please ensure that you include your name and an explanation as to why you are sending us money.
