1. Two Day Rally: This is the biggest single opportunity to showcase our club and we have an enviable reputation for putting on a good show. As always it is the volunteers who make it great and your donations of time, goods or money are what make it such a great value weekend of riding.

In the past we have enjoyed the great pre-prepared meals brought in by many of you and your friends and family. This year the rules have changed and all meals will be prepared onsite by Covid approved methods. Donations of your time, goods or money are still very welcome, just slightly different.

As members of the host club, we all share the responsibility to ensure our guests are safe. This means we should all encourage compliance with the social distancing and hygiene rules as will be displayed on-site and announced regularly on the PA.

2. C4C and 404: The new Concessions For Classics (C4C) Scheme will become law on 16 April 2021. This will allow modified vehicles greater access to legal road use and is separate to the Code 404 Concession scheme we use.

Due largely to successful lobbying by the CMC and member clubs, the proposed changes to the 404 scheme are now on hold for a further 12 months so there should be ample time for consultation and negotiation. We are attending the relevant CMC meetings and will be ensuring that any and all concerns we have are presented.
