LICENSING LIAISON OFFICERS RE-PORT

Changing from A Class (full license) to B Class (Code 404)

The procedure for "B" class concessional licensing is as follows: A Current "A "Class license paper will be required to show the Examiner. The Member then contacts ANY IHC Examiner who carries out a Compliance inspection of the vehicle and compares it to the license papers.

He completes and authorises a CMC1 (Certificate of Financial Membership) Form, then passes a copy of the CMC1 to the club Licensing Liaison Officer (LLO) who will then enter it into the IHC Official Register.

The Authorised CMC1 is then issued to the applicant to take to the licensing authority (along with any license papers or other proof of ownership) to complete the licensing process.

The licensing authority will require the applicant to complete a form E81 (license concession form). This is a formal declaration that the vehicle is to be used only for club sanctioned use and will be properly maintained in a safe and unmodified condition.

On completion of the licensing, the applicant then attaches a yellow "HISTORIC" plate above or below the number plate. (Available from the club treasurer at club meetings). The vehicle is then ready to participate in club events.

Jeff said that if you are coming up to age 85 and have received a medical form from the Department of Transport it is in your best interests to contact him so that he can advise you on filling out the form.

If you are going on a ride that is longer than your 30 klms test rides, email the secretary and this becomes a formalised impromptu ride and will safe guard you if you are pulled over by the law. Just take a copy of the email with you and you can produce it if you are pulled over.

There is also a form for impromptu rides on the documents page of the website.

NEW RULES AND BYLAWS

As part of the process of ensuring that our club conforms with the Associations Incorporation Act 2015 it is proposed to replace the current club constitution with new rules and by-laws.
