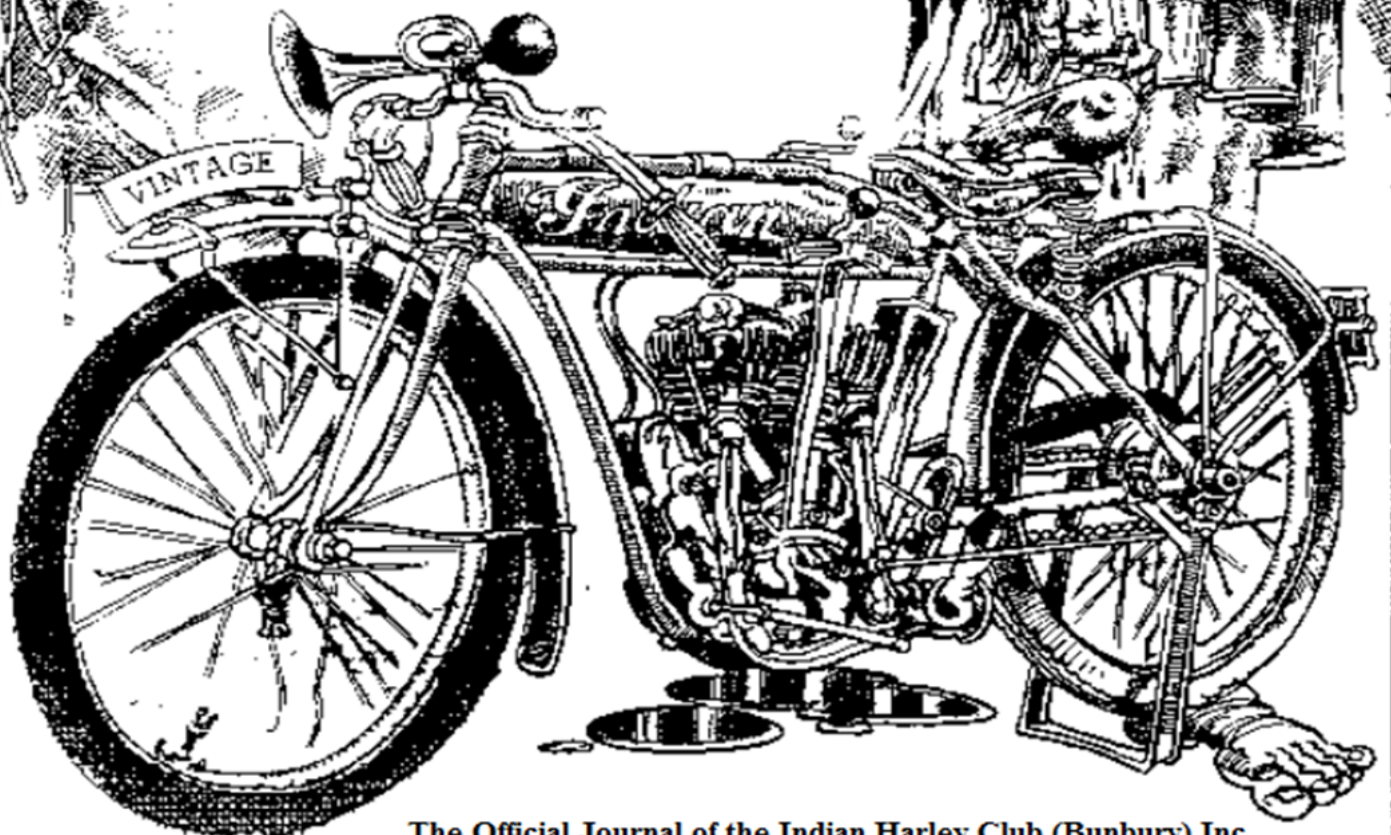

PRESIDENTS REPORT

The proposed changes to the club by-laws are now finalised and have been on the club website for the last month for all to see. Those proposed changes will be raised later in General Business, and a vote taken on that proposal.

Also, your committee is looking into a way of relieving the stress on club officials at the end of year when membership fees are due. We are trying to ease the load on our Treasurer and License Liaison Officer regarding those members who are habitual late payers of their membership fees. As this will mean a possible change to the rules, it needs to be decided quickly so that it can become an agenda item for the AGM.

This will be discussed further next week at the committee meeting, along with a report on our club annual budget which will enable us to determine whether our annual fees are sufficient for the effective running of all club activities.

We still have a low annual fee structure at present, \$45 or \$50 per year is pretty good for what the club achieves. In comparison, the VMCC fees vary between \$60 & \$70 a year, according to their website. More on that next month.

Neville Green has obtained a quote from a local company, Bozbuilt, in Australind for a new trailer. After some discussion, it was decided that it requires a couple of changes and will be discussed again next Wednesday.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Amendments to Club Bylaws

Firstly, tonight we have a bit of important business to take care of, and I'm referring to the proposed changes to our club By-Laws.

These proposed changes were introduced at the March General Meeting and have been available on the club website since the middle of March for all to see. Hard copies have also been available to those without computer access and are again available here tonight.

I will briefly run through the proposed changes, as there is a reasonable chance that someone hasn't checked what the changes will be.

As you will have seen, the basic form of the committee will be retained, with four (4) Office Holders, (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer), and eight (8) Ordinary Committee Members. In addition, there will be fifteen (15) Subsidiary Officers: Machine Examiner, Captain*, Vice-Captain*, License Liaison Officer*, Newsletter Editor, Librarian, Membership Manager*, Property Officer, Dating Officer, IT Officer*, Merchandise Manager, Pre '48 Liaison Officer*, Mandurah Liaison Officer, Busselton Liaison Officer and Manjimup Liaison Officer).

Of those fifteen Subsidiary Officers, five will be required to regularly attend committee meetings. They are: the Captain*, Vice-Captain*, License Liaison Officer*, IT Officer* and Pre '48 Liaison

Officer*, effectively making them Ordinary Committee Members.

The posts of Publicity Officer and Assistant Secretary are to be removed and that of Membership Manager added.

This is only a summary of the changes; the complete proposed updated by-laws, including job descriptions for each position have been available since the middle of March.

I am assuming there are no issues regarding these proposed changes, as no one has contacted me since the last meeting. I have to add that the time for changes to the proposal has passed so if anyone disagrees with any part of the proposal, you will have to vote against it in its entirety.

Before I propose the motion, does anyone wish to comment on these proposed changes?

The Motion is: Proposed by Richard Clark, seconded by John Presland that the document entitled 'Proposed By-Laws April 2018' as published on the Indian Harley Club website be made the By-Laws of the Indian Harley Club replacing any previous By-Laws.

All those in favour, everyone. All those against, none. I declare the motion Carried.

Glenda is proposing to run another "Lucky \$100 note" Raffle in the near future, in aid of the Relay for Life Appeal. I must point out that as our constitution does not allow us to raise funds for outside interests, this is a private venture, but the opportunity to participate will be offered to IHC members as well as the general public. Glenda will be happy to take your money.

Some interesting news from the Albany Classic & Vintage Club this week. They have preliminary approval for a hill climb to be held this year on Marine Dve, starting from the Middleton Beach end. Dates will be the usual

first weekend in November, that's the 3-4 November. I think that could be quite interesting as it isn't a particularly steep hill, but it does have some fairly long, and possibly quick bends.

Tuart Forrest Restoration Group. Centenary on Sunday 13 May. Mother's Day. Main aim is forest restoration. Trying to get the air of a 1920's settlement with period motorcycles and cars for effect. Murray has arranged for around 12 starters for the event at Ludlow forest settlement.
