General Information

The 2-Day Rally is the gala event of the Indian Harley Club of Bunbury and will be based at the clubhouse of the Bunbury Motorcycle Club, located on the South Western Highway, adjacent to the Bunbury Airport.

Each day's run will commence and conclude at this location. Entrants will be eligible to win awards and trophies. The Saturday run consists of a long and short course. Please note start time 9.30 am. The course distance for the long course will be between 200 - 240 km and the short course distance will be between 110 -140klms.

The Sunday run is just one course to be completed by all riders. 110 - 140klms.

Free tea/coffee will be available self-serve from Saturday morning.
