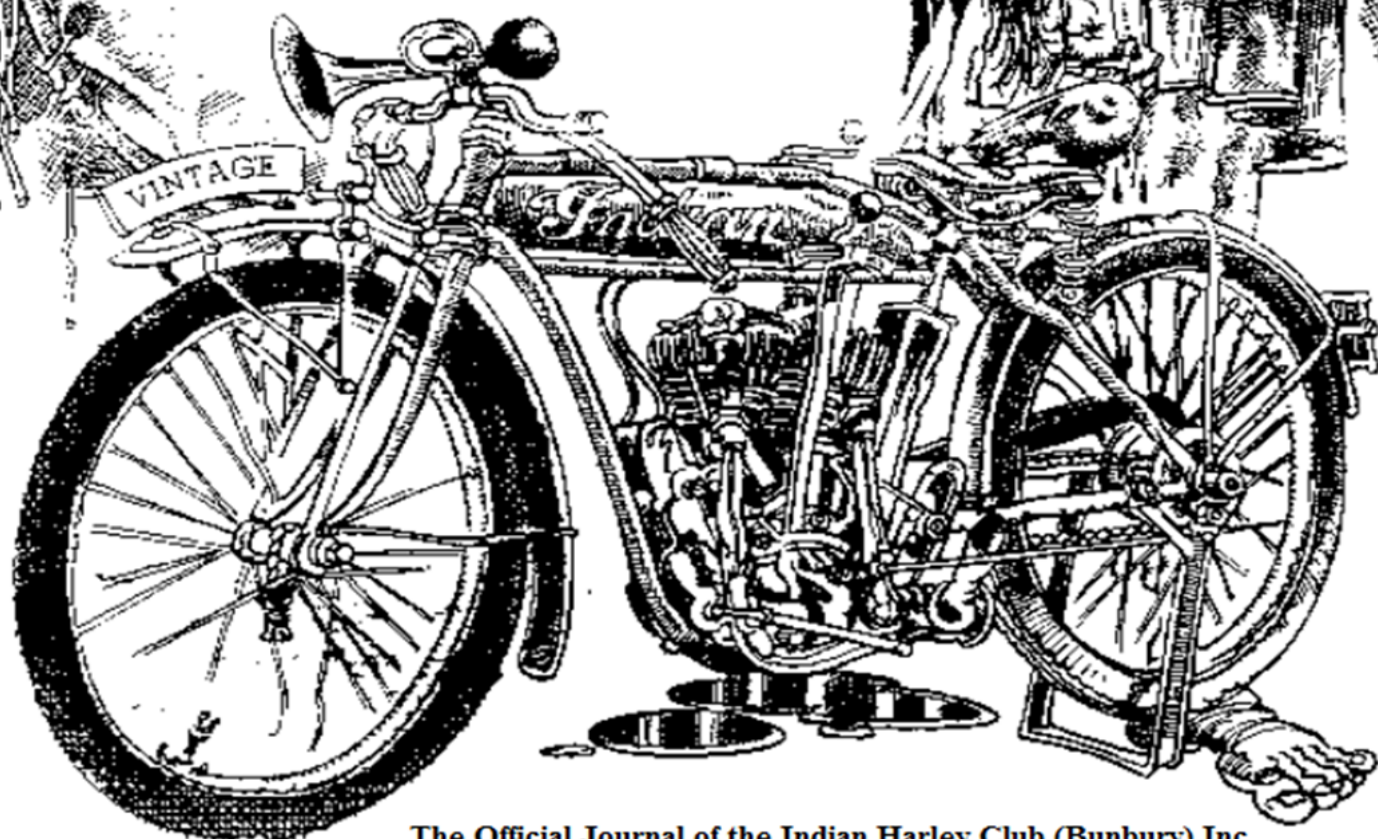

**Margaret River Show**

We are invited to display our bikes for the Margaret River Show now confirmed for the 19th October 2019. Michael Rock has contacted the show organising committee and completed the registration form, we now need a volunteer to arrange the details for the day.?

**Try out Day**

The date has been set for the now annual "Try out Day" which provide an opportunity to test ride some different bikes will be held on the 24th November, the Mandurah Mob will be travelling down to join us on the day.

**Tuia Lodge Bike Display**

In keeping with the club commitments to visit retirement homes to display our bikes Tuia Lodge in Donnybrook has asked the

club if we can show some of our bikes to the residents soon. John Keenan will be organising the visit, if you would like to participate please see John for details.

### **National Veteran Rally**

The sub-committee for this event held a meeting on the 24th August. Significant interest is shown with this event with around 30 people attending the meeting.

### **Entry to Club Grounds**

The entry road to the club grounds is difficult to see at night, to enhance the entry point fluoro tape has been put on the sign and Bert has installed a couple of solar lights to make it more visible at night. Discussions with Main Roads has commenced to provide a more permanent solution.

### **Membership Fees**

A reminder that membership fees are now due.

### **Ladies Luncheons**

To make it simpler for ladies to pay for their luncheons, George will be setting up an on-line pay facility soon. We will advise when this is completed.

### **Code 404 Audit**

At the time of writing this report there were still 60 members who have not responded to the audit requirements.

The audit has proven worthwhile with several discrepancies found. The club LLO (Jeff) will be sending out a reminder email to those who have not responded.

A reminder to those that have not responded that the IHC has a responsibility to ensure all club motorbike registration records are current and accurate, failure to comply with the IHC

requirements is not an option.

### **DoT Audit**

The clubs DoT Machine examiner (Murray Rudler) has advised that the Department of Transport has recently conducted an audit of the club inspection premise's and associated documentation.

Pleasing to see that the auditors were very happy with the club's processes. The auditors advised Murray that we will most probably have to purchase a headlight tester and a sound level meter. On behalf of the club our sincere thanks to Murray for a job well done.

### **2 Day Rally**

Seems like we have just recovered from the 2 Day Rally held this year and we are now starting to get organised for the 2020 event. The first meeting of the organising committee will be held this month. There will be an absolute maximum of 200 entries and no late entries will be accepted.

### **Mid-week Rides**

During the club captain's absence Leith Presland has kindly volunteered to organise the afternoon mid-week rides. Confirming that the start times for mid-week rides are 0930 hrs for the morning ride and 1330 hrs for the afternoon rides.

### **Club Trailer**

Several members have requested to borrow the club trailers for either personal use or transporting their bikes to events.

The committee has re-affirmed the previous club policy that the trailers are restricted to the express use of club events i.e. back-up requirements and transporting equipment to club approved events.



## **Impromptu Rides**

It has recently come to the attention of the committee that the forms we currently use for the above rides do not completely satisfy the code 404 requirements.

The code requires that all impromptu rides must also identify the individual bike used for the ride. To minimise the complexity of complying with this requirement, for a single rider the form will have a check box to enable the bike registration details to be entered.

For multiple riders on an impromptu ride we will add a column on the indemnity form for the registration number of all bikes participating.

On a lighter note I understand one of our founding members has recently celebrated an 80th birthday milestone. The club wishes Norm Hart all the best.

## **LICENSING LIAISON OFFICER'S REPORT**

The importance of completing the 404 Audit accurately was stressed. The members were reminded that if the information on the club register or the bike's licence papers was incorrect, the bike was not registered.

Jeff suggested that the best way to ensure the club had the correct details for the bike was to take a picture of the bike, which clearly showed the licence plate number, and submit it with the completed audit form.

The club's contact in the DOT has retired.

This has led to a push to remove the licencing authority from the motoring clubs, which will result in a large increase in the cost of registering your bikes.

If you have bikes that need to be registered it is advisable to register them as soon as possible.

### **Peter Whiteside**

Peter advised members that Mr. Trevor Dolan had donated \$150.00 to the club; the money was the proceeds from the sale of motorcycle parts that were no longer required.

### **Peter Hume**

Peter and Jack rode over to the Bulli Antique Motorcycle Weekend that was held on 24-25 August. While there they had a talk with one of the organisers of the Inaugural Cannonball Classic, that will be held during 2021.

The run will go from the Busselton to Eden, on the coast of New South Wales. The riders would travel approximately 400km / day and would be responsible for

providing their own backup and support crew.

The event is planned be a semi-regular event, with other rides from Darwin to Adelaide and Broome to Townsville proposed for the future.

Peter also advised members of a motorcycle accident on Henty road, and reminded members to ride safely and to leave at least 1.5m between bikes when overtaking.

### **Frank Baron**

Frank reminded members that the mid-week ride to Narrogin, on the 23 October would start at 08:00 am from Eaton.

Backup would be provided by Neville Green. All members would be welcome, including members who drove to Frank's property, just for the social side of the run.

He also advised members that Mr. Bob Greer, from Platypus Charities would be a guest speaker at the December club meeting.

Platypus Charities run 3 motorcycle rides in Vietnam per year as fund raising events.

### **Leith Presland**

Leith advised members that the mid-week ride would be to the Brookhampton Hall, starting at 1:30pm in Eaton. As it was Glen Britza's birthday, there might also be a little something special for him.

She also confirmed that Leithal's Run would be held on Sunday 6 October 2019.

### **Jeff Smith**

Jeff notified members that Des Baily's wife had passed away.

He also asked members if anyone had used

LED lighting on their bikes. Peter Hume said that he believed the LED lights appeared brighter during the day but weren't as bright at night.

### **Gino Mazza**

Gino's nephew rode through India on a Royal Enfield bike. Not many details were forthcoming, but Gino believes he had a fantastic time.

### **Michael Rock**

Told members of a story he had been told many years ago about a rider who hacked one side off a 500cc Triumph Speed Twin motor with a hacksaw, plugged up the rest of the motor and raced the bike in the 250cc class.

A little research revealed that the story was true. Michael managed to locate the remnants of the motor, which were on display at the meeting.

### **VIP Member Introductions**

Michael Rock introduced Phil Tyler. Phil was born in England, the only boy in a family of 6 children. As a boy delivering newspapers around his hometown, he dreamed of owning a Jawa motorcycle.

His first bike was an Ariel Golden Arrow, which he promptly crashed into a car on the first day. He had to pay for the damage he caused because he had no licence and subsequently no insurance.

He had a series of English bikes after that including an Ariel Leader and several Norton ES2s before buying a Suzuki. He like the Suzuki, as in his words "it had brakes that worked and started easily".

He raced bikes in England and thought he had done well on his first race until he

found out that he finished 20TH out of 22 riders. His racing career was not without its highs and lows and made for interesting listening.

After moving to Australia in 1978, Phil took on a job in Port Moresby as a trade instructor. During his 3 years there he was robbed 3 times and soon realised why he got the job so easily.

Phil currently lives in Donnybrook. His bikes include a 1972 Jawa 360 twin and a Jawa MZ, which hadn't run for 19 years, when he obtained it. He found that it took about 36 kicks to start it, and then it didn't run properly. He has since fitted a Mikuni carburettor to the bike which has improved things significantly.

Depart Bendigo 1400 Sunday 17 Nov

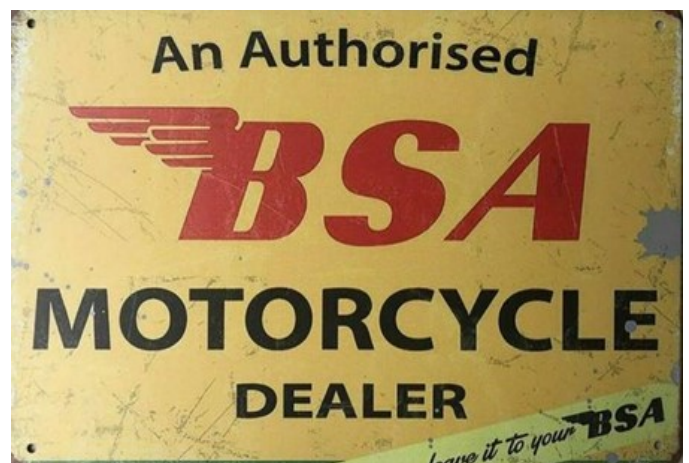
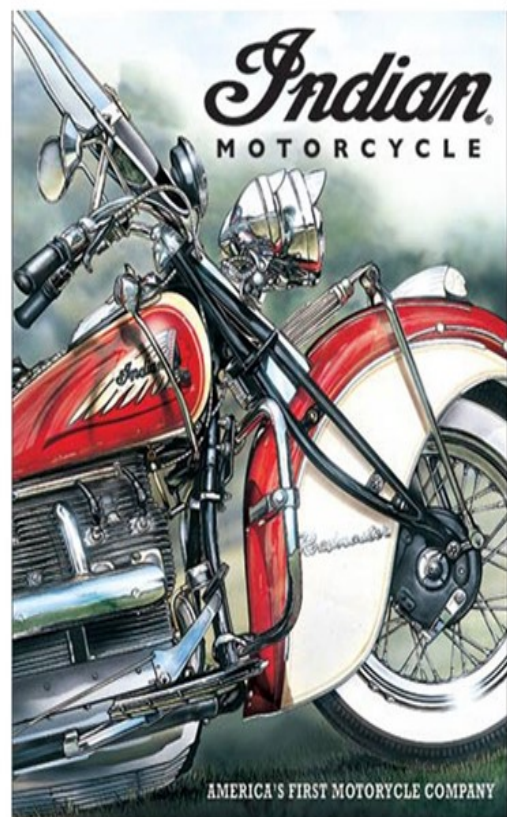
