More Sidecars

MORE SIDE CARS.

My first sojourn into sidecars was after an 18 month hospital stay as a result of a serious motorcycle accident in 1974 where I was left unable to walk.

I went to live in Carnarvon to both recuperate and also help set up a motorcycle shop for my friend with the 147 INDIAN CHIEF and sidecar.

Keen to continue with my fishing and shooting interests I fitted a sidecar to an RV90 SUZUKI which became affectionately known to all as "The Goat Chaser".

This little unit lent a great part to my recovery and upon leaving Carnarvon a few years later, sold it to a caravan park manager to use in the park.

On returning to Bunbury in 1978 I brought a GOLDWING GL 1000 with me to use as a sidecar tractor but after riding the bike for a while could not bring myself to changing it from a great solo machine.

Last year after reaching 74 years young, and after scuffing up my BLACKBIRD a few times with my crook leg failing while parking, I decided to fit a sidecar to one of my BLACKBIRDS.

This has been and interesting technical procedure with the BLACKBIRD having the conventional aluminium ring frame as do most sport bikes, so attaching a sidecar required some inventive thinking.

I first built a steel adaptor which extended from about half way along the swing arm to the front of the engine. This 50x50x2.5 RHS is attached to the main frame at the swing arm axel/rear upper and lower engine mounts, side stand mounts, and forward to the front top engine mount. At each end of this adaptor are (2) NOLETHANE bushes with acentric centres which allow easy toe in/out adjustments as well as soft mounting the side car frame to the adaptor. Lean support is provided by (2) shafts, rose jointed to the upper part of the adaptor and to the side car frame by rubber shock absorber mounts. This also allows for easy lean out adjustment. The epoxy composite body is supported at the rear by (2) half elliptic springs and a centrally forward fitted rubber mount. The sidecar wheel is a sports bike rear with disc brake and FLEXITOR rubber axel mount. The sidecar disc also has a hand brake calliper. In order to retain the linked brake setup, I fitted another rear master cylinder in tandem to the existing rear brake cylinder.

Both rear and sidecar wheels are fitted with 190x45x17 car tyres which properly fit the bike wheels. These car tyres only require 10mm toe in (over the length of the outfit) rather than the approximate 20mm usually required. Lean out is still about 20mm which is to allow for camber in the road which is really a ball park measurement to cater for a large variation in road cambers. The outfit handles really well with the unchanged front end, only being heavy on steering on some road conditions. The bike still has clip-ons and the approximate 100mm trail for solo riding. On the open highway you can safely let go of the handlebars and although a steering damper is fitted, it is regulated to zero. To compensate for riding without a passenger I have fitted a 15I fuel tank and a 15I water tank under the body, and a car battery under the side car seat which is charged by a mounted 40watt solar panel. The outfit has adequate power and with a foot change to change down with the clutch, and a hand change to change up by throttle as my foot does not work properly, it can be exciting at times on wet roads and accelerating in

The weather then, will be perfect so here's to a great roll up.


