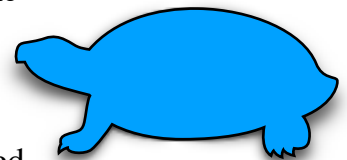
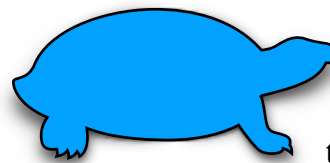

The Quinninup Tavern put on a great lunch as usual.

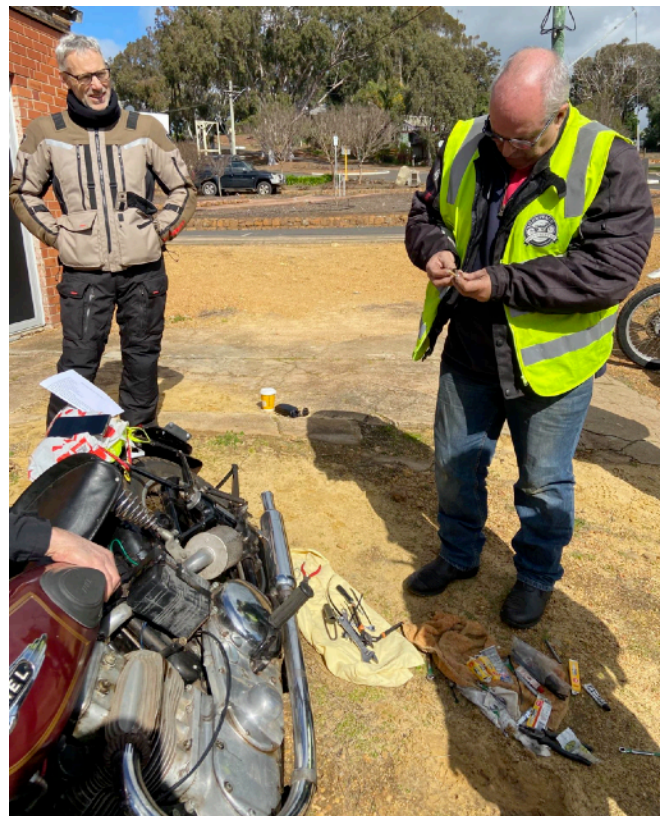
The roads were very quiet with virtually no traffic at that time during the week.

The weather then, will be perfect so here's to a great roll up.

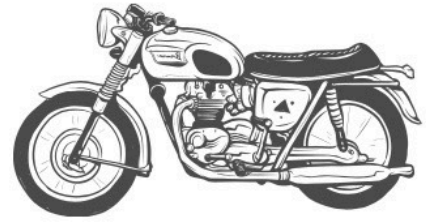

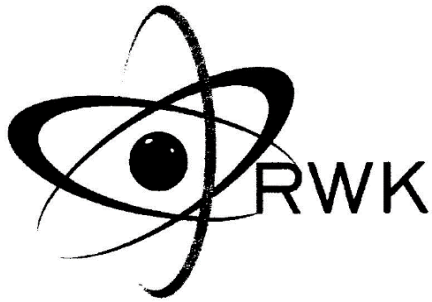
