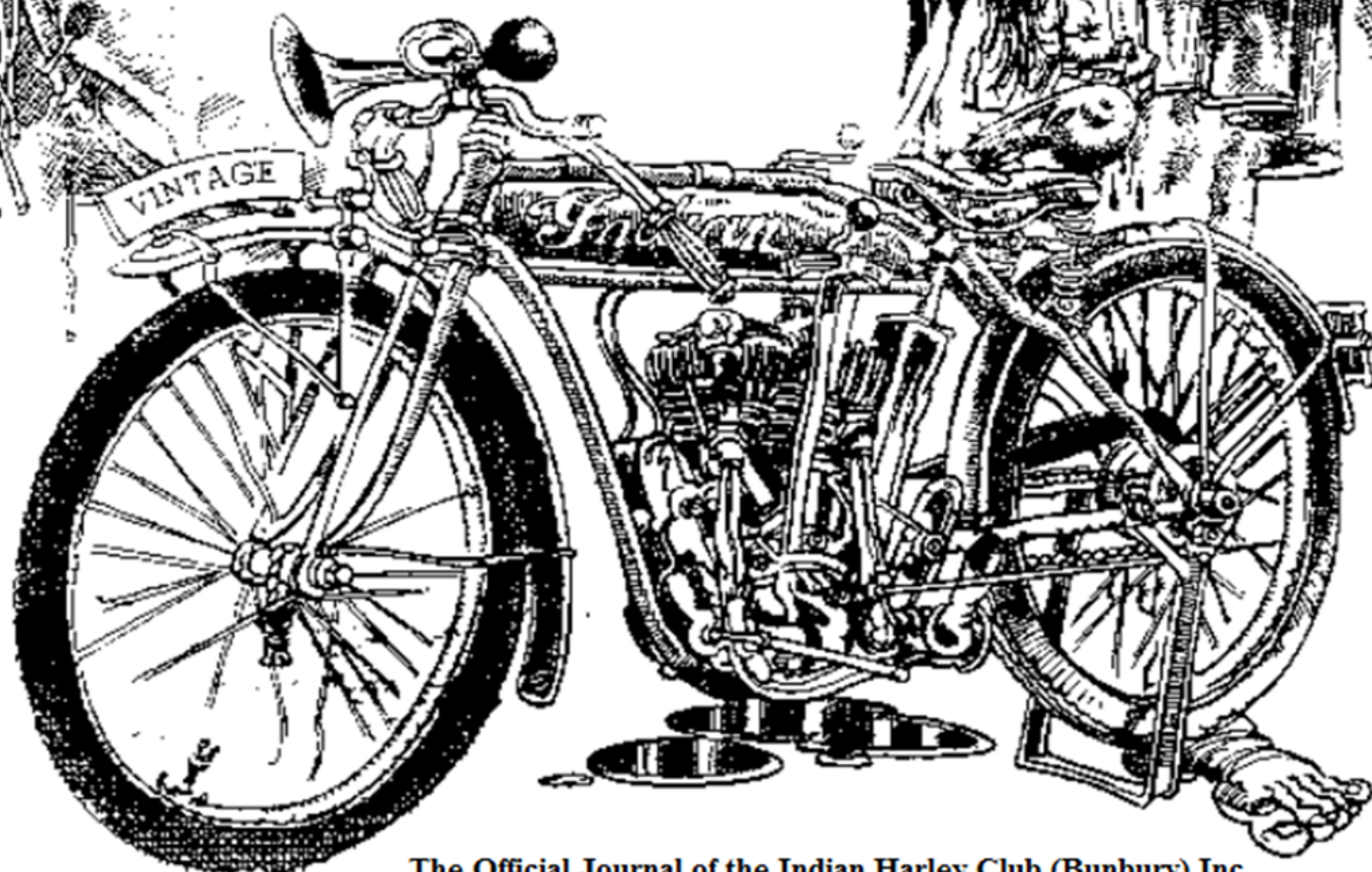

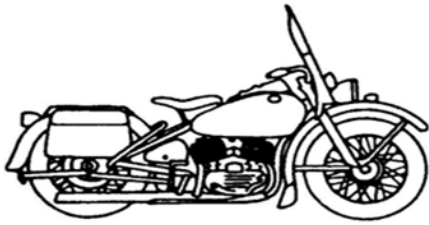

Jeremy has also created an exciting new event in October that I am very much looking forward to.

Finally, we lost a few members in the past 12 months. Some of those members had a high profile in the club, some not so much but they will all be remembered in our thoughts and our stories.

CAPTAINS REPORT.

Our club has had a busy year, with approximately 230 items passing through our calendar and membership has grown to approximately 550. Group leaders are reporting good attendances at their events, as is our main group here in Bunbury.

The Two-Day Rally was a big hit this year, possibly the best ever and our club, made a modest profit of \$3000 from this event.

We always need new volunteers to run this club and to help conduct our various events, or maybe even consider a committee position.

Those members who have organised events throughout the year, driven the backup vehicle, or have done whatever it takes to help run events, thank you for your support.

Sadly, we have lost several of our members over the last couple of years, all of them irreplaceable.

But overall, a positive year for our club.

Back to current activity.

Bunbury Mid-Week. 12th July 2023.

We dodged a bullet with the weather today, as it remained fine for the duration of our ride. 15 riders presented at the usual Eaton Hall starting point, all on modern type bikes. Following the rider's briefing, we set off on a rather longish ride of approximately 160 kilometres.

Today's course took us along Henty Rd, Pile Rd, Wellington Forest Rd, Gnomesville, Charlie Creek/Wildmere Rds., Brookhampton Rd, out onto the Sth West Highway and into Donnybrook. From there, along Goodwood Rd and on to the Capel Bakery for our morning tea stop. Coffee and pies were the standard order from our members...surprisingly. The place was packed with customers and being school holidays, made for a very noisy room.

Following morning tea, most members continued along a set course over to Boyanup, via Railway Rd. Just before the Sth West Highway T junction...a police roadblock. Everyone had to be breathalysed and I am pleased to report that all our members passed with flying colours and were wished a cheery farewell by the friendly policemen.

Then it was over to the Dardanup Bakery for more coffee, pies and conversation and the end to the day's proceedings.

It was my first visit to this venue, and I thought it was a good choice, as Ross had used it previously on his rained-out Tortoise Rides.

We even had three lady members join us for the morning and an enjoyable one and a half hours was had, catching up with events over coffee.

Mid-Year Run. 30th July 2023.

With the weather looking a little iffy, 15 riders and 1 pillion still fronted up. Once Janet finished dressing Leigh and passed on some instructions re dressing, the troops were called to order in almost sunshine. The ride took us out of Eaton to Hynes Rd, Clifton Rd onto Raymond Rd, Alma Rd, Clifton Rd, through Brunswick onto Southwest H/W to Sandalwood Rd.

At the start, Martin Rd was a concern, but on arrival, it was probably the best we have experienced in the winter months. Next was Hope Ave to Government Rd, just to shake breakfast down and be ready for the pies and coffee at the Crooked Carrot.

After solving most of the global problems, we headed back to Wellesley Rd, then navigated the missing pieces on the route sheet, which everybody passed with distinction. After all that, we headed back to Brunswick, SW H/W, Raymond Rd and back to the starting point.

No weather issues, just some misty rain here and there. Great winter ride with good camaraderie. Great to see some old bikes out for a run. Thanks to Val for doing the back-up job.

PROPERTY OFFICER'S REPORT.

It has been an easy year as far as the club's shed and its contents go. During the shed inventory inspection carried out in May, several cor-flute signs associated with the 2-day rally (1 x "NO BYO" and 4 x "Solo's") and the trailer's electrical plug adapter were missing. The adapter has been replaced, but the signs have not. There were several items associated with the 2 Day Rally were added to the inventory list, along with other items which were not listed previously.

The small amount of rust that was found at the bottom of some wall panels on the south side of the shed and reported in last year's report was treated with fish oil over summer. This treatment appears to have been effective as there has been no discernible increase in rust since it was treated.

An accident with the shed door resulted in the need to get professional help to replace the damaged trolleys and rehang the door. While the repairs were being carried out, several improvements were made, both to ensure the accident could not re-occur and to make opening the door an easier operation. The track on which the door hung from was moved further to

the right side to enable the door to open the full width of the shed opening and a stop was installed to prevent it from opening further. The existing 2 guides at the bottom of the door were removed and a longer single guide was installed to remove the necessity to line up the door when opening it.

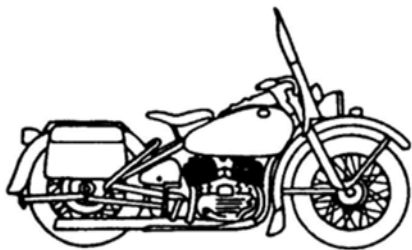
