A Kids Corner with Pony Rides and McDonalds Animal Farm.

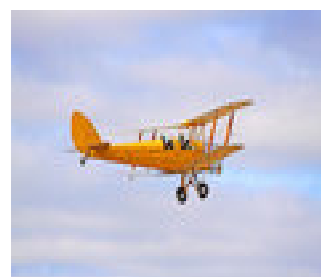
Then Clydesdale/Wagon rides, or Helicopter Rides for the more adventurous.
