Privacy Policy

1. This document was issued by the Indian Harley Club (Bunbury) Inc. on Wednesday 16th July 2014.
2. The term 'The Club' in this document means the Indian Harley Club (Bunbury) Inc.
3. This document details the type of information The Club collects and holds on you, and the purposes for which it is used by The Club or disclosed to others.
4. When applying for membership of The Club and during the course of your membership The Club collects personal information about you and motorcycles that you own.
5. This information may include but is not limited to - your name, residential address, date of birth, phone number, mobile phone number, email address, details of your partner and details of motorcycles that you own.
6. The primary purpose of acquiring this information is for the proper administration of The Club, and to enable The Club to communicate with you.
7. Your personal information may be kept as paper records and as computer records. Computer records will be stored on secure commercial servers and on computers which are under the control of committee members. Committee members will have access to this information. All records in the possession of committee members will be kept securely and used solely for administration of The Club.
8. All or some of this information may be disclosed to third parties only for the proper administration of The Club. Examples include but are not limited to, insurance companies, financial institutions and vehicle licensing authorities. Personal information will not be disclosed to third parties for commercial or marketing purposes.
9. By default your name, phone numbers, email address and membership level will be visible to other members in a secure 'members only' section of The Club website to enable other members to communicate with you. You have the option to vary or remove the information displayed.
10. The full membership register of The Club can be inspected and copied by any member of The Club as required under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1987*.
11. Records held by The Club may be inspected by members of The Club where allowed under the constitution of The Club.
12. Information may be disclosed if required by law or court order.
13. Your participation in The Club and its activities, including but not limited to, attending meetings, rallies, rides, displays and social events may be reported in The Club magazine, on The Club website, in newspapers, on radio or TV or other media. Such reports may also include photographs of you, family and friends, and your motorcycles.
