Expressions of interest are now invited for the 2022 Veteran Vehicle Rally in Busselton WA. To register your interest please click on the Register button on the VCCWA website, or contact the Rally Director, details below. At this stage, all we require is your contact details so you can receive information as we go along. Formal entries will be sought nearer to the event at which time people will hopefully have their vehicle details available.

The weeklong rally will follow the conventional format with rally registrations on Sunday 23rd October, followed by 5 days of Veteran Motoring and finishing off with a dinner on the evening of Friday 28 October.

Whilst there have been previous rallies in the Busselton area, there are still lots of new and interesting places to visit during the week. The Busselton area has an abundance of quiet back roads with few hills making it ideal for veteran motoring.

Accommodation

There are many accommodation options available in Busselton, the ones listed below are all relatively close to the Rally HQ, distances as shown. Most of them have some space for trailer parking, however, a trailer parking area will be arranged in case of overflow.

In all cases, Rally Entrants will have to make their own accommodation arrangements. The establishments below have all been approached and as of September 2021 have good availability but they are all expecting to fill up relatively quickly.
